Museums Emergency Programme PROJECT BIBLIOGRAPHY

ICOM is currently collaborating with the Getty Conservation Institute (GCI) and ICCROM (International Centre for the Study of the Preservation and Restoration of Cultural Property) in a series of regional courses designed to assist museum personnel in safeguarding their collections from the effects of natural and human-made emergencies. The goal of these courses is the increased capacity of museum professionals in integrated emergency management, a term that encompasses risk assessment and mitigation, as well as emergency preparedness, and response. Integrated emergency management requires the knowledge, skills and experience of a broad range of professionals, including those from the security, risk mitigation and disaster preparedness fields.

These regional courses—entitled *Teamwork for Integrated Emergency Management*—are being carried out within the framework of ICOM's Museums Emergency Programme (MEP), which aims to make information and other resources on integrated emergency management more readily available to museum personnel. MEP's education initiative has resulted in the development of a **searchable web-based bibliography** that covers a wide range of literature on the subjects of emergency preparedness and response for the heritage field. Topics range from specific types of emergencies to the various types of heritage resources they can affect, such as museums, libraries, archives, places of worship, historic buildings, and other culturally significant sites. The bibliography also reflects the various processes of integrated emergency management—risk analysis, development of plans, and response and recovery efforts.
