Dear Colleagues,

You will find enclosed the **instructions to be followed in nominating candidates for the election of the 2010-2013 Executive Council**. The election will take place during the Shanghai General Conference on November 7-13, 2010.

1. CONDITIONS FOR THE NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES

Board Members of National and International Committees may nominate candidates from their own Committees or others. They **must** ensure that:

Condition 1: The nominee is an individual member or a designated representative of an institutional member of ICOM in good-standing (paid-up membership)

Condition 2: The nominee is willing and able to serve as a member of the Executive Council. The candidate must acknowledge that he/she will be responsible for all expenses related to his/her position if elected.

Condition 3: The nominee complies with the limitation of two consecutive terms at the same position within the Executive Council as stated per Article 11 section 1 of the ICOM Statutes (Vienna 2007).

2. CONDITIONS FOR THE SUBMISSION OF CANDIDACIES

Condition 4: Candidacies must be submitted by email at the following electronic address: election2010@icom.museum **before December 31st, 2009**

and

Condition 5: Candidacies must be submitted to the ICOM General Secretariat, postmarked **December 31st, 2009**:

Condition 6: To be valid a candidacy must provide the following both documents:
a. the Nomination Form,
b. the Candidates Biographical Note.
