This may include the conception or design of the work, or the acquisition, analysis or interpretation of data for the work. In addition, each author is expected to draft the work or critically revise it for important intellectual content, approve the final version of the manuscript, and agree to be accountable for all aspects of the work to ensure its accuracy and integrity.

Authors warrant that no contribution containing essentially the same information has been published previously in any format, except in the form of an interim report, an internal report or an in-house journal, and that the material is not in the process of publication elsewhere.
